First Nine Weeks Review Project - Honors Geometry

You will create a book using vocabulary words that you have learned so far this nine weeks. To do so you will choose a geometry term for any **15 different** letters of the alphabet. (No letter should be repeated.) For example, angle for A or endpoint for E. For each page in your book you will:

- 1) State the letter of the alphabet,
- 2) Give the geometry term and a brief definition,
- 3) Provide an illustration of something man-made which contains/describes the term, or provide a picture of something from nature which contains/describes the term.
(Your pictures may be drawn by hand, clipped from a magazine, photographed by you, or found in Google images. No clip art.)
- 4) Your source for your image should be documented on the page. (Name of magazine, website, or name of illustrator/photographer – YOU!)
- 5) Booklet can be any size or shape, but the goal is to have an attractive review booklet. Be creative!
- 6) Some suggestions:
 - Do not use notebook paper. It does NOT look as neat.
 - Typing each page will look better than writing it out.
 - If you must write it because you don't have access to a computer, please be sure to be NEAT and write in PEN! If you make a mistake, do not just cross it out. That is no longer neat, and points will be deducted.
 - If you need assistance with getting any of the needed supplies, please see me by March 16th, so I can try and help you, depending on your circumstances.
